Minutes of the Meeting of **EVESHAM TOWN COUNCIL** held at 6.30 pm on **MONDAY 14 NOVEMBER 2016** in the Council Chamber, Town Hall, Evesham.

84. Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors Barclay, Bulman, Kaler (Town Mayor), Homer, Boyd, Haynes and Sandalls.

85. Declarations of pecuniary or other interest (if any)

Cllr M D Elliman declared a non-pecuniary interest in minute xx, as he is a member of the historical society.

Cllr C Tether declared a non-pecuniary interest in minute xx since he had put forward one of the New Homes Bonus (NHB) projects.

Cllrs Mrs F S Smith and M S Goodge declared non-pecuniary interests in minute xx, NHB, since they sat on the localism panel at Wychavon District Council, which dealt with NHB applications from town and parish councils.

Cllr J S Smith OBE declared a non-pecuniary interest in minute xx planning applications (a) and (f), since the applicants were known to him.

86. Announcements by the Town Mayor

The Deputy Mayor thanked all those who had volunteered at the annual bonfire night and attended the Remembrance Service. He went onto remind members of the Mayor's Curry Night in aid of his charities which was taking place on 22 November 2016.

Cllr J S Smith advised members of the Worcestershire All Age Autism Strategy, copies of which had been tabled for information and which could be downloaded from <http://bit.ly/2gXUKtp>. He also advised that Evesham had recently been given Dementia Friendly Town status.

Cllr A P Booth reminded members of the Bengeworth Remembrance Parade that was to take place on the 20 November.

87. Minutes of the Previous Meetings

It was **RESOLVED** to recommend that this application be approved subject to the usual conditions.

Relocation of existing Transport and Haulage business and construction of new premises on Plot 510, Enterprise Way, Vale Park. (Use classes B2 and B8)

It was commented that Sinclair's had been looking to move from their current premises for over a decade. They were a prominent local company and this proposal would remove HGV traffic from Davies Road. It was **RESOLVED** to recommend that this application be approved.

91. Proposed Residential Parking Space – Ash Grove

Circulated with the agenda was a report detailing a proposed disabled parking space to be provided outside 55 Ash Grove in Evesham.

It was commented that the proposed location was quite close to the turning head and it was asked whether the space could be moved further away.

It was **RESOLVED** to support the provision of the disabled parking space but to add that the authorities should investigate moving the space away from the turning head.

92. Wychavon District Council's Chairman's Diamond Jubilee Community Recognition Award 2016/17

A letter was circulated from the Chairman of Wychavon District Council, Cllr Mrs F S Smith, asking for nominations for the Community Recognition Award. Groups or individuals could be nominated who in the opinion of the community have given exceptional service to others. The winner would receive a trophy and a bursary.

It was **RESOLVED** to delegate any nomination to the Mayor and Deputy Mayor.

93. Evesham New Homes Bonus – Public Consultation

The Clerk circulated with the agenda a report detailing a proposal to hold a public meeting on the 13 December 2016 at which all the New Homes Bonus project proposals would be presented. WDC had stated that as part of the public consultation process a public meeting was advisable. The Clerk proposed to invite all the projects to do a short presentation to those in attendance. Some sort of questionnaire/survey would be produced to gauge support for each project.

It was **RESOLVED** to hold a public meeting, provisionally set for 13 December 2016, at which all the projects that had been approved for consultation by the Town Council would present.

94. Almonry Update

Circulated with the agenda was the Almonry Update, detailing the latest visitor figures, projects and events. The Almonry manager was also present to answer any questions. He manager presented the visitor figures for the past 9 months, detailed below.

The manager went onto inform members of the success of the recent Bredon Hill Roman Coin Hoard exhibition which had seen an increase of 8% in visitor numbers when compared to the same period last year. The talks had also been well attended and the feedback very positive.

The Almonry had been well supported throughout the year with work experience and volunteers contributing their time. Particularly pleasing were the 3 student placements over the summer.

The Manager went on to inform members that she was working with WDC and The Valley to develop a tourism project in the new year. The project hoped encourage coach drivers a fresh offer

in order to encourage them into the town and to deliver a promotional campaign to highlight Evesham.

The Almonry had been placed on the 'At Risk' register by English Heritage and the manager recommended that an HLF bid be submitted that focused on the restoration of the building and gardens. Whilst the building was not going to fall down, the At Risk status meant that it required urgent work in the very near future. The refurbishment of the museum and the exhibits would be done under a separate bid. The Manager's draft HLF project proposal was subsequently circulated to members via email and no objections were raised.

Ms Jayes was thanked for her report.

95. Provision of Dog and Litter Bins by the Town Council

The Council had been asked to review its policy of not purchasing any dog or litter bins for areas that were not its property. Members were aware that whilst WDC were the authority responsible for litter and waste, they had adopted a policy of not providing new or replacement bins anywhere in the district unless they were paid for by the local town/parish council or through sponsorship.

The anti litter strategy that had been a product of the Town Council had asked the Town Council to consider the purchase of some bins. The strategy had identified a number of 'grot spots' that a new bin may help to resolve, but WDC policy meant that the onus fell on the Town Council.

Costs depended on size, but there were on-going costs including annual cleaning and emptying fees for each bin.

It was commented that as waste was the remit of WDC it was not the Town Council's responsibility to provide bins. It was also commented that in new developments, WDC should make the provision of new bins a planning condition.

It was **RESOLVED** to reaffirm the Town Council's policy not to purchase any dog or litter bins, (other than for its own green spaces, cemeteries etcetera) as it was the responsibility of WDC.

96. In accordance with the Public Bodies (admission to meetings) Act 1960, it was **RESOLVED** that the public and representatives of the press and broadcast media be excluded from the meeting during the consideration of the following item of business as publicity would be prejudicial to the public interest because of the confidential nature of the business to be transacted.

97. The Almonry – Collection Report

In confidential session the Manager updated members on the recent issues regarding the collection. It was **RESOLVED** to continue to support the manager regarding the collection.

98. Reports from Council's Representatives

There were no reports.
